### Officer Reports:

SNCC: 4/5/6 September 2020, a request was made for more flyers, always rather scarce.

Trustee: Peter reported that only 45 members of our region come regularly to Region Assembly out of a potentially much higher number as all Intergroup LO's ought to be in attendance as well as Region Reps. He wonders how many understand how Region and the whole structure works. There are 110 Intergroups across 16 Regions in the country.

Treasurer: Brian proposed sending £18,858 to GSO but after discussion it was agreed to send £10,000.

The remaining 2020 Region Assemblies are confirmed as 15 March, 28 June, 20 September (+workshops), 22 November.

The postponed issue of moving the election of all officers to the annual AGM was discussed, it concluded with a vote unanimously to maintain the current situation.
