Meeting Minutes

1. Open

a. Welcome and Traditions

2. Administration

3. Minutes from 170th Assembly

4. Vacancies & Elections

a. VACANCIES

- i. MSIG has one vacancy for Region Rep No Candidates
- ii. New position: Safeguarding Liaison Officer; Peter G presented his application to Intergroup. Voted by poll. Accepted by majority. Peter was welcomed onto the Committee
- iii. Seth rotating out at the June Assembly: Armed Services Liaison Officer
- 5. Chair: Bob S. outlined a proposal to spend £1,600 on a full-page advertorial in the Surrey advertiser. It is felt that the timing is appropriate as MSIG is engaged in railway station poster advertising, the Darkness into Light exhibition in Woking and Guildford libraries and a PI event in Guildford Guildhall. The newspaper feature is planned for Friday, 8th April (2 days after the PI event) and will be supported by online activity (Get Surrey / Surrey Live) and on Facebook. MSIG will receive a feedback report to quantify the reach of our ad. The Mayor of Guildford will open the PI Event on 6th April.
 - Q: received by email; should AA advertise? Tradition 11? The long form of the Tradition encourages us not to engage in sensational advertising

Samantha D; liked the idea and agreed it's appropriate to use the Surrey Advertiser.

Volunteers needed to pop into each library throughout April to attend to the Darkness into Light exhibits, help to keep them tidy and advise PI of literature that needs to be ordered. The proposal was agreed by a majority of votes on zoom poll.

- **6. Treasurer:** Jon updated that we finally have control of our bank account with HSBC. Contributions from groups is back up to pre pandemic levels. Income should be on budget at £26k. Costs over the last 4 months are on target. However, the cost of Google Ads has recently increased dramatically from £500 to £900+ per month. The volume of clicks and impressions has risen accordingly but it is difficult to justify such a huge outlay. Following discussions at Committee, the account has been put on hold pending further investigation. If the account remains on hold, we should save £6k £8k this year. £4k of the budgeted £6k has been sent to SE Region. Intergroup to vote on the next contribution to Region at the June Assembly.
- 7. Barbara Archivist; shelves and display stands have now been sent up. Barbara showed the storage and archives video; the new archives facility is located in the Big Yellow Storage unit near Brooklands Shopping Centre in Byfleet. Now open for AA members to visit. Email: Barbara (Archivist) or Bob (Chair) if you are interested in visiting. Barbara prefers weekends / Bob happy to visit on weekdays
- 8. Yvette PLO Railway poster advertising campaign running until 13th March on stations in the Mid Surrey area. Very successful campaign. Reason we switched from buses to trains is that Guildford bus station is now closed. On 6th April our main PI event is to be held at the Guildhall in Guildford. Officially opened by The Lady Mayoress and her Consort. Professionals in the local community to attend in the afternoon. Refreshments and AA literature packs supplied. Presentations, an Open Meeting Workshop and Q&A session. Al-Anon participation.

Saturday, 25th June: MSIG Convention at Millmead Baptist Church

Samantha (Thurs Guildford) experience from another fellowship of the success of advertising in Wetherspoons pubs. Some intergroups have AA coasters or beermats in pubs. AA coin disc to give to patients or doctors to keep in pockets. MSIG to get costs of coasters and coins for further decisions at our June Assembly.

9. SE Region has asked us to support the Furlough contributions:

Mid Surrey Intergroup voted by poll to support SE Region in its opposition to GSO receiving furlough payments during the pandemic. Conference 2022 will be asked to decide that the contributions should be returned to the government. The £36k will stay on AA's accounts until Conference or GSO reach a final decision

Workshop on Home Groups – Venue TBC to be held on 10th May – approval for rent on premises and AA Literature is approved. Jon has a budget £250.

Peter G – Safeguarding Officer – to attend the Home Group workshop and be available to discuss his new role
