Service position: <u>Prison Liaison Officer</u>

Term of office: minimum 2 years. Maximum 3 years

## **Requirements:**

- Minimum 2 years of continuous sobriety
- A good understanding of the 12 Traditions of AA
- Regular attendance at meetings in the Mid Surrey Intergroup area
- Willingness to visit a wide variety of meetings in the intergroup area to inform groups of the availability and benefits of Share magazine
- Available to attend 4 Committee meetings, 4 Assemblies and 2
  Region workshops per year

## **Duties:**

- Liaise with AA members who are currently co-ordinating fellowship activities at Send and Coldingley prisons
- Report back to Intergroup with news from the prisons and the current state of play
- Report to Assembly on requests from the prisons for AA support (AA literature / visitors for meetings)
- Co-ordinate the supply of requested literature to the prisons
- Generate a list of AA members who are willing to attend meetings in the prisons and make sure that they have adequate security clearance
