Term of office: minimum 2 years. Maximum 3 years

## **Requirements:**

- Minimum 2 years of continuous sobriety
- A good understanding of the 12 Traditions of AA
- Regular attendance at meetings in the Mid Surrey Intergroup area
- Willingness to visit a wide variety of meetings in the intergroup area to inform groups of the availability and benefits of Share magazine
- Available to attend 4 Committee meetings, 4 Assemblies and 2 Region workshops per year

## **Duties:**

- Maintain contact with Probation / Criminal Justice Social Work Services Offices in the Mid Surrey Intergroup area, ensuring that they have regular contact with people in our Fellowship
- Supply AA literature to Probation / CJSWS offices
- Liaise with Prison and Public Information Liaison Officers to maximise support for clients wishing to attend AA meetings
- Report to Assembly on requests from the probation service to supply AA literature and/or CHITS (confirmation of attendance at meetings)
